Geotechnical Engineering Faculty Position: The Department of Civil, Construction and Environmental Engineering (CCEE) at Iowa State University (www.ccee.iastate.edu) invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position in Geotechnical Engineering at the full professor level beginning August 16, 2010. **The successful applicant will hold the endowed James M. Hoover Chair in Geotechnical Engineering.** The geotechnical engineering program at Iowa State University is a national leader in geotechnical research and education and enjoys strong industry support.

Candidates for this position must hold a bachelor's degree and Ph.D. in civil engineering (or related field) with emphasis in geotechnical engineering. Candidates considered for this position should have an appropriate level of academic and scholarly success commensurate with tenure and appointment at the senior level. National distinction and international recognition in geotechnical engineering are required, as well as strong communication skills. Preferred qualifications include a proven track record in obtaining extramural funding to support scholarly activities that are complementary to current departmental efforts. As the successful candidate will organize the annual Hoover Mentoring seminar, experience organizing conferences seminars or symposia is preferred. Interdisciplinary research efforts are encouraged. Professional registration or licensing, or the ability to become registered, is encouraged within the department.
